

# Basal Repudiating Techniques for Alleged Satanic Verses Story: Narrated in Some Sīrah Literature

#### **Abstract**

This paper intends to adduce the basic and easy tricks to negate the alleged story of Satanic Verses which is also called "Qiṣṣat Al-Gharānīq". In which it's reported and alleged that Satan interjected some words in the revelation of Sūrah al-Najm. Actually, this study struggles for the easement of the reader, that how easily the matter of this story would be understood and negated. In order to achieve this target, the analytical method of research has been adopted here. The basic and common techniques – which are amazingly ignored by the propagators of this story – are being introduced here in this article for an easy rejection of this story. As we know a number of Qur'anic verses that prove its Divine protection from falsehood. Being inscribed in a preserved tablet, it can't be intervened or changed by Satan. According to Allah Almighty, the Prophet of Islam (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) can't commit any error instead of speaking only the Divine Revelation exactly. So, how couldn't he recognize the cursed Satan. The alleged satanic words can also not be adjusted in Sūrah al-Najm because the rest of the verses are discrediting instead of praising the pagan deities. On the other hand, chronologically it's also impossible that the alleged satanic interpolated words may remain un-abrogated for a long period of Nine years because the verses 52 to 54 of Sūrah al-Ḥajj – which are considered as the abrogating verses – revealed after the Hijrah occurred almost nine years later from the revelation of Sūrah al-Najm. So, the article under observation, extensively, represents the basic, common and quite easy methods, through which this story can be repudiated very comfortably.

# **INTRODUCTION:**

This article is, in fact, a sequel of a couple of earlier published articles1 of the author regarding the comprehensive introduction and historicity of Satanic Verses story (*Qiṣṣat al-Gharānīq*). The said narrative had been reported in some sources of early Islamic history that in a meeting with Quraiysh at Ka'bah<sup>2</sup>, the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) was allegedly deceived by Satan. As he recited the verse أَفَرَ عَيْتُمُ 'Uzza? -Lāt and al-''Have ye thought upon al  $^3$  ٱللَّٰتَ وَٱلۡعُوۡرَىٰ وَمَنَواٰهَ ٱلثَّالِثَةَ ٱلأَخْرَىٰ $^3$ And al-Manāt, the third, the other?"<sup>4</sup>, it is alleged that the words in praise of the pagan deities (تلك الغرانيق العلى وان شفاعتهن لترتجى "Indeed, they are high" flying cranes, and their intercession is to be hoped for") have been casted and mixed in the recitation by Satan. It is also alleged that the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) didn't recognize him and recited the rest of Sūrah al-Najm. After that the archangel Gabriel (A.S) visited the Holy Prophet (SAAS) and informed him about the Satanic interpolation that the words – of praising deities – were, in fact, not from God, but interpolated by Satan. He, furthermore, clarified his position that he had never spoken these words to him. By revealing the verses 52 to 54 of Sūrah al- Ḥajj Gabriel abrogated these Satanic words.

The above mentioned story is all about the Holy Qur'ān which is entirely protected by God Himself. So, this paper produces the basic techniques to reject this story. The authenticity of this narrative is being refuted here through the primary Holy Qur'ānic principles which cannot be disputed at any stage.

# THE NOVELTY OF THE STUDY:

By reviewing the literature related to this topic, it is understood that historically, a plenty of scholars has exercised their intellectual powers on the refutation of Satanic verses story (*Qiṣṣat al-Gharānīq*) like Nāsir al-Dīn al-Albānī in his "*Nasb al-Majānīq li nasf Qiṣṣat al-Gharānīq*" (1996 AD) al-Maktab al-Islāmī Beirut, Alī b. Ḥassan al-Ḥalabī al-Atharī in his compilation "*Dalā'l al-taḥqīq li-ibṭāl Qiṣṣat al-Gharānīq*: *Riwāyatan Darāyatan*" (1992 AD) Maktabah al-Ṣaḥābah Jaddah *etc*. But they had a lack of concentration to make this story rejected quite easily. Because they had often got the complicated processes of investigating the status of the quoted traditions and *Riwayahs*. In this study, a general reader can easily understand comparatively some basic and easy tricks to refute this story.

# THE QUR'ANIC EVIDENCES OF REJECTION:

In rejection of the story of *Gharānīq* many factors and evidences have been adduced throughout the history of Islam. But on the whole, the importance of the Holy Qur'ān is not hidden from anyone. So, firstly, the alleged story must be sifted and inquired through the Qur'ānic criteria.

Prior to all, **the protection of the Divine Revelation** has been taken by God Himself as He stated:

"Lo! We even We reveal the reminder and Lo! We verily are its guardian".

It is reported that the Satan had interpolated the message of God, which endangers the authenticity of the Qur'ān. Here Allah (the Exalted) negates this sort of alarming situation that along with the descent of the Qur'ān, the protection of this Qur'ān is also attributed to Allah (the Almighty). This protection includes several aspects like its preservation, memorization, and changeability *etc*. So, whose Protector is God, who can even dare to harm that one?

As Allah (the exalted) Himself is the Protector of His message, He guaranteed in the following verse that **the falsehood has nothing to do with it**:

"Falsehood cannot come at it from before it or from behind it, it is a Revelation from the Wise, the Owner of Praise".

With all this protection and guarantee, how the Satanic or Qurayshite falsehood could be placed in it. Is there anyone who would be able to challenge Allah's protection?

Further, the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) has been alleged to be the deceived character in the story, which seems totally unimaginable in the light of the following verses:

In these verses the conversation about the devoted and purified slaves (men) of Allah (the Exalted) has been carried on. Hold for just a minute and ponder that **who is better devoted and purified than the Holy Prophet** (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him)? Is there anyone who claim it? Obviously not. Allah (the Exalted) Himself declared and Satan posited it too that he has no control over the God's devoted and purified ones. So, it could not be possible for Satan to deceive the best purified and devoted person like the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him).

For the preservation of the authenticity of the Qur'ān, Allah (the Exalted) warns even the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) in the following verses as:

"It is the Revelation from the Lord of the worlds and if he (the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him)) had invented false sayings concerning Us, We assuredly had taken him by the right hand and then severed his life-artery and not one of you could have held Us off from him".

Here the accusation – of the Holy Prophet's (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) compromise on the basic belief of Islam *i.e.* the Unicity of God – has been outrightly refuted. Allah (the Exalted) is straight forwardly warning in case of any fabrication to His message. So, for why, on mixing and entering the Satanic suggested words in the recitation of the Holy Qur'ān, the life-artery of the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him), has not been cut off by God? Why had he not been punished severely (Allah Forbid) according to this injunction of Allah (the Exalted)? The answer is only that this kind of any incident had not been occurred ever.

While taking keen interest in the verses in which this term has been used, it becomes obvious, that the Divine purpose of these verses is to give messages. This purpose has been high-lighted very well. The recipients of these messages have the following classifications: firstly, the Holy Prophet of Islam (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) a paradigmatic recipient of God's messages, other Prophets (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon them), the mother of Moses (A.S), and the disciples of Jesus (A.S), Angels, the bee, and the Heavens. The *Waḥy* was not restricted only to the Prophets, but has been descended to several other creatures. By this, the sole purpose of God was to give guidance to his creatures. So, it is unimaginable, that the guidance from Allah (the Exalted) maybe susceptible to any other power like Satan, as in the Qur'ān:

"And he whom Allah (the Exalted) guideth, for him there can be no mis leader".

That is to say, that **whom, guided by Allah (the Exalted) can never be miss-guided by any other**. How the Divine guidance or Revelation may be interrupted by Satanic intervention? Similarly, at another occasion, Allah (the Exalted) clarified the un-susceptibility of the Divine Revelation as stating:

"Falsehood cannot come at it, from before it, or from behind it, It is a Revelation from the Wise the Owner of praise".

Having this kind of clear injunctions from Allah the Almighty, how can one dare to even imagine the Satanic intervention in the Divine message. So, the adducers of this story seem at odds to a common rational concept of the Divine Revelation, that it cannot be susceptible or affected by any Satanic power.

Thus, it is evidently cleared that the Divine Revelation cannot be affected by any outer intervention. How is it possible that the Revelation – which is **inscribed "in a preserved tablet"** مُحَفُوظِ may be intervened by some other power *i.e.* Satan.

As far as the allegation that during all the process of *Waḥy*, Satan assumed the form of arch-angel Gabriel (A.S) and interpolated the Holy Prophet's (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) recitation of *Surah al-Najm* and had not been recognized by him. All these had been nullified by the following verse:

إِلَّا مَنِ ٱرۡ تَصۡىٰى مِن رَّسُولِ فَإِنَّهُ يَسۡلُكُ مِنُ بَيۡنِ يَدَیۡهِ وَمِنۡ خَلۡفِهَ رَصَدَا 12

"Save unto every messenger whom He hath chosen, and the He maketh a guard to go before him and a guard behind him."

That the arch-angel is attended from front and back by the guardian angels during the descent of the revelation. No one can harm this divine process by intervening or by assuming the form of anyone else. And the alleged error in recognition of Satan has also been neglected here very well,

مَا ضَلَّ صَاحِبُكُمْ وَمَا غَوَىٰ وَمَا يَنطِقُ عَنِ ٱلْهَوَىٰۤ إِنْ هُوَ إِلَّا وَحَيِّ يُوحَىٰ أَن "Your companion (Muhammad) has not strayed, nor has he erred, nor does he speak out of his Desire. This is nothing but a Revelation that is conveyed to him".

Because Allah (the Exalted) has ousted here even a single chance of the erring Prophet. The fact is that the infallibility is compulsory for the truthfulness of the Divine message. So, what is abstaining the adducers of this story from positing the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) as infallible? Is this not an inspiration from the outer sources? The answer is left for an intellectual reader.

The control of Satan too may not be exercised on the sincere and devoted men of God. These are the men who cannot be strayed by Satan, who is the biggest hurdle in proclamation of Divine message. So, the protection from the deception of Satan has been granted to the true servants of Allah (the Exalted), as stated in the Holy Qur'ān:

إِنَّ عِبَادِي لَيْسَ لَكَ عَلَيْهِمْ سُلُطَنَّ إِلَّا مَنِ ٱتَّبَعَكَ مِنَ ٱلْغَاوِينَ 14

"Lo! as for My slaves, thou (you) hast no power over any of them, save (except) such of the froward as follow thee (you)".

It is explicitly stated that the cursed Satan has no control over those, who are the true obedients of Allah (the Exalted). He (Satan) has no power to beguile the sincere servants. In this verse, Allah (the Exalted) accepted Satan's challenge of beguiling his creation, and made him clear that he would have no control over His true servants. On another occasion Satan himself confess that he has nothing to seduce any of those men, who has been chosen by Allah (the Exalted). His statement is quoted in the Qur'ān as:

قَالَ فَبِعِزَّ بِكَ لَأَغُوبِيَنَّهُمْ أَجْمَعِينَ إِلَّا عِبَادَكَ مِنْهُمُ ٱلْمُخْلَصِينَ 'He (Satan) said: then bye Thy might I surely will beguile them everyone, save (Except) Thy (Your) single-minded slaves (Men) among them".

The "single minded" or "chosen" indicate, firstly the Prophets and Apostles of God, who have been no doubt chosen by God to convey His message. So, it is quite evident now that the Satan's tricks can't work on the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) and he can't be deceived by Satan because he is the highest ranker in the "chosen slaves". Thus, it is necessarily compulsory to comprehend that the allegations of the story of *Gharānīq* entirely wrong and have no authenticity. Because as above, the Protector of the Revelation is God Himself, so, no one can ever dare to change its words. The devoted and purified persons are out of control of Satan, and of course, the best of them is the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him), how can he be deceived by Satan? And in case of fabrication into the Qur'ān, Allah (the Exalted) has announced severe punishment, so on this alleged fabrication why the Holy Prophet has not been punished severely? All these indicate the rejection of occurrence of this incident of *Gharānīq*. It should not be named as authentic at any stage.

# INTERNAL ASSESSMENT OF SURAH AL-NAJM:

Surah al-Najm is the alleged related Surah to the story of Gharānīq. Its internal assessment must be done in order to reveal the truth behind the alleged story. For this internal evidence, let us analyse the accusation that the Satanic interpolation has been occurred in Surah no.53 al-Najm. This interpolation proved to be a cause of the unbelievers' delight, who were present at Ka'bah. They had a prostration too, following the Holy Prophet as a gesture of friendship and goodwill. For commenting on this story, it is necessarily required that the Surah should be read while adding the alleged Satanic words to know what it actually meant to be delivered by this allegation. So the Surah with the alleged verses would be as under:

"Have you seen Lāt and 'Uzzā? And Manāt the third, the other? [These are high flying cranes whose intercession is to be sought]. Are yours the males and His the females? That indeed were an unfair division. They are

but names which ye have named, ye and your fathers, for which Allah (the Exalted) Hath revealed no warrant they follow but I guess and that which (they) themselves Desire And Now the guidance from their Lord hath come unto them". <sup>16</sup>

By reading the *Surah* including bold parts — which shows the alleged Satanic suggestion — as in above passage, one cannot understand the revealing purpose of this *Surah*. How may it be possible that the pagan deities are being praised on one hand, and in the subsequent verses they are being discredited on the other hand? Because it is narrated that after The Satanic Verses the Holy Prophet recited the rest of the *Surah al-Najm*. So the rest of the *Surah* has obviously discrediting verses regarding these deities. It seems very amazing that while having this type of discrediting and disgusting verses, how the Qurayshites drew the conclusion that the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) has made a move to reconciliation and the policy of give and take? If the alleged incident has some authenticity then it would not have been easy for unbelievers to be glad on such a repellence of their deities in the remaining verses of *Surah al-Najm*.

# CHRONOLOGICAL SEQUENCE OF RELATED VERSES:

Examining the alleged story chronologically, one will must come to the result of rejection of this story. These considerations cast doubts on the story's authenticity, which are enough to repudiate it. The reporters and publicizers of this story, had combined some verses of at least three *Sūrahs* like *al-Najm*, *al-Isrā'*, and *al-Ḥajj*, and they thought, these verses had been revealed on a single day, to which evidences are not true. Further, it can easily be understood in the sense of determination of period of revelation, this historical criticism will absolutely validate this story or negate it.

As we know that the alleged incident of reciting the Satanic Verses and consequent prostration of disbelievers along with believers in the Ka'bah has been alleged to occur after the Migration of the first group of Muslims to Abyssinia. According to the most of reliable sources that migration occurred in the month of *Rajab* in the 5<sup>th</sup> year of Prophethood<sup>17</sup>. The alleged verses were of *Surah al-Najm* 53:19-20.

Now come to some other alleged and related verses to the story of *Gharānīq* which are verses 73 to 75 of *Surah al-Isrā'*. These verses, according to historical sources, were revealed after the event of *Mi'rāge*<sup>18</sup> *i.e.* Ascent of the Prophet, which has been occurred in the 12<sup>th</sup> or 13<sup>th</sup> year<sup>19</sup> after the Prophetic call. So, it implies that the Satanic interpolation was not detected even for a long period of 6 or 7 years. As far as the verse number 52 of *al-hajj* is concerned, it has been narrated to be revealed after the

Hijrah<sup>20</sup> i.e. Migration of the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him) and his companions to *Madinah*. So, the Satanic interpolation was said to be occurred in 5th year of the Prophethood and admonition about it has been revealed after 6 or 7 years. Interestingly, the abrogation of those Satanic words is reported to be done after almost 9 years. Can it make any sense? That means, the Satanic interpolation was not detected by God Himself (God forbid) for nine years or He allowed the Muslims to recite those alleged verses. A sensible and unbiased mind can deem it very easily that these kinds of allegations cannot be supported at any cost.

This chronological analysis implies that deeming the story of *Gharānīq* true, is equal to posit that the Muslims had been asking the pagan idols for intercession for a long period of 9 years, which displays their compromise on the basic monotheistic believes. It is therefore, not acceptable for any rational person.

# **CONCLUSION**

Therefore, this article went for negating the alleged story of Satanic verses in a very easy way. It introduces some universal Qur'anic manners to counter the narrative of abovementioned story. First of all, going through the several verses, we got a lot of refuting points, as in Sūrah al-Hijr Allah Almighty takes the responsibility of the protection of the Divine Revelation Himself and in Sūrah Fussilat and on another occasions, HE declares that the falsehood cannot be mixed in it from any direction because during the descent of the Wahy, the arch-angel is attended from front and back by the guardian angels. So, this Revelation is inscribed "in a preserved tablet" which can't be dislocated or intervened. If Allah (the Exalted) Himself declared and Satan also accepted it that he has no control over the God's devoted and purified men, then it would not be possible for Satan to deceive the best purified and devoted person like the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allāh be upon him). We found very strong clue also in the starting verses of Sūrah al-Najm itself, that the Holy Prophet (Peace and greetings of Allah be upon him) is not strayed, not erred and does not utter with his desire but this was only the divine revelation.

The internal assessment of *Sūrah al-Najm* also helped to negate the above-mentioned story. Because the alleged satanic suggested words cannot be fit after the verse 20. This would be quite unfair to adjust these in between verses 20 and 21 of this *Sūrah*, because the rest of the *Sūrah* discredits the pagan deities contrary to these alleged praising words. And also by analyzing the time of revelation of the related *Sūrahs* like *al-Najm*, *al-Isrā'*, and *al-Ḥajj*, we came to the result that it is not possible to leave these alleged satanic words un-abrogated for such a long period of nine years. So, all about the

story Satanic verses may be considered as fabricated in the light of above easy, general and basic principles and methods.
